Crime and Punishment

Note: There are TWO assignments for you to complete. You must do both!

Copies of *Crime and Punishment* will be available in the Cottage Office for pick up during summer hours.

Assignment One:

As you are reading the novel, find **three** important quotes from **each** of the following characters: Raskolnikov, Sonya, and Svidrigailov. These quotes should reveal significant personality traits or the character's worldview. Write a paragraph explaining why each quote is important. (Make sure you write down the page number of the quote.)

Assignment Two:

Because Raskolnikov is still serving his prison sentence in Siberia, he is unable to attend the marriage ceremony of his sister, Dunya, and his best friend, Razumikhin. Write a letter from Raskolnikov to Razumikhin. Razumikhin will open the letter the morning of his wedding. This letter should be at least two pages (TNR, 12 size, double spaced).

Helpful hint:

Reading of *Crime and Punishment*: The long Russian names can be overwhelming in this novel. Adding to the confusion is that most characters are called multiple names in the book. I would suggest you find a character list to assist your reading. If you are using an Arborbrook copy, the character list is on page 466. Happy Reading!
